Your proposal will be submitted electronically. Please make sure you have all the files necessary to upload ready before beginning.

Submissions must be received by November 1, 2016 and proposers will be notified by December 1, 2016.

Information to be included in your proposal & submission format:

- You will type in text including your name, title, organization affiliation, postal address, telephone number, and e-mail address
- You will type in the text of your proposed presentation title
- You will type in the text for up to a 250-word narrative description of the proposed presentation
- You will UPLOAD the following files:
 - Abstract file to be saved with the filename being the session title, in either the .doc, .docx or .pdf file formats.
 - A .jpg, .jpeg, or .png format headshot photo of each (up to 4) proposed presenter(s) in your submission
 - Curriculum vitae for each proposed presenter, in either the .doc, .docx or .pdf file formats
